APPEALING AND MINERAL DRY WHITE WINE

Bourgogne Aligoté Les Chailloux Silex

TASTING NOTES

Visual: Pale golden colour, crystalline, silver glints. Nose: Complex, fresh fruit and white fleshed-fruits (pear, peach), notes of flint. Palate: Finely cut, very aromatic, intense, acidulated and mineral.

WINE AND FOOD PAIRING

As an aperitif or to accompany dishes such as sushi, spring rolls, antipasti, tapas, seafood pasta, grilled fish, white meats and mild cheeses.

On family occasions, we serve it with "gougères" (choux pastry with cheese), ham terrine or snails.

Serving temperature: 10-12°C.

WINEMAKING AND MATURING

Grape variety: Aligoté.

Vinification: Gentle pressing at low pressure to protect the quality of the juice. Maturing: In temperature-controlled stainless-steel tanks to preserve the fresh aromatic charm.

THE TERROIR

The grapes for this Aligoté wine are grown on carefully selected plots of land. The wine owes its uniqueness to its heritage in the Côte Chalonnaise region at the very heart of Burgundy. The vines are planted on limestone and marl hills, rich in silica. The pebbly soil is strewn with fragments of flint called "chailles" or "chailloux" in French.

DID YOU KNOW?

Aligoté is Burgundy's second most popular grape variety, though it's often outshone by the more famous Chardonnay. This ancient plant was created by crossing Pinot Noir with Gouais, a variety that no longer exists. The Aligoté grape grows in Yonne, the Côte d'Or and Mâconnais, but the Côte Chalonnaise vine is currently the most successful.
